**RESOLUTION NO. 4921**

A resolution authorizing the Chairman or the Secretary to offer no objection to Carline Management Company, Inc., EM-20-010-2413 for a permit to install and maintain anchor piles, chains, buoys and spar barges for a block moored barge fleet, in the Mississippi River, right descending bank, about 122.4 miles above the Head of Passes, near Luling, in St. Charles Parish, Louisiana.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the St. Charles Parish Council acting as the Governing Authority of the Parish:

**SECTION I.** That the Chairman or the Secretary be and is hereby authorized to offer **NO OBJECTION** in connection with the application of Carline Management Company, Inc., EM-20-010-2413 for a permit to install and maintain anchor piles, chains, buoys and spar barges for a block moored barge fleet, in the Mississippi River, right descending bank, about 122.4 miles above the Head of Passes, near Luling, in St. Charles Parish, Louisiana.
