COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ST. CHARLES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD AND ST. CHARLES PARISH

THIS AGREEMENT made this day of gray, 2009, by and between the ST. CHARLES PARISH SCHOOL BOARD ("SCHOOL BOARD") herein represented by its president, Stephen M. Crovetto by virtue of a Resolution of the School Board adopted on 20 May, 2009, and whose address is 13855 River Road, Luling, Louisiana 70070, and ST. CHARLES PARISH ("PARISH") herein represented by its president, V. J. St. Pierre, Jr., by virtue of Ordinance No 16 dopted by the St. Charles Parish Council on 15 June 2009, and whose address is 15045 River Road, P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, LA 70057.

- WHEREAS, it is the intent of both the SCHOOL BOARD and the PARISH to provide for and maintain the quality of life for the residents of St Charles Parish; and
- WHEREAS, the Parish through its governing authority is responsible for and required to provide the public service of equipping, maintaining, and operating public libraries, as the public demands require; and
- WHEREAS, the operation and providing of properly equipped and maintained libraries to the public is important and vital to the general education and welfare of the public; and
- WHEREAS, the SCHOOL BOARD recognizes the value of a properly equipped and maintained library to the public and its general education and welfare; and
- WHEREAS, there is a need to provide a properly equipped and maintained public library in the Paradis area of St. Charles Parish; and
- WHEREAS, the SCHOOL BOARD owns a portion of land in or near Paradis, St.

 Charles Parish, Louisiana, that is no longer needed for school purposes and has been declared by the SCHOOL BOARD to be surplus property; and
- WHEREAS, the PARISH desires to erect, maintain, and equip a public library facility in or near Paradis, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE SCHOOL BOARD AND THE PARISH hereby enter into this Cooperative Agreement for the purpose of operating and providing library services to the public through the construction and equipping of a public library in or near Paradis, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, subject to the following:

1. The term of this Agreement is for the length of time that the Parish operates and provides library services to the public at the specific location and on the specific property to be donated by the SCHOOL BOARD to the PARISH, unless a shorter period of time is mutually agreed upon;

- 2. The SCHOOL BOARD shall donate the subject property to the PARISH, and construction of the library branch by the PARISH is required to begin within two (2) years of the date of the Donation of Property contemplated by this Cooperative Endeavor Agreement.
- 3. That should construction of the library branch not commence within the time frame stated herein, said property shall revert to the SCHOOL BOARD;
- 4. That at any time in the future the donated property is no longer used as a public library, it and all improvements thereon shall revert to the SCHOOL BOARD;
- 5. That should either of the reversionary clauses contained herein be implemented, the SCHOOL BOARD shall have the right to demand of the PARISH, and the PARISH shall be obligated at its sole expense, to remediate the property and improvements thereon such that they are free of any and all potential and/or existing environmental contamination liabilities, to the reasonable satisfaction of the SCHOOL BOARD.
- 6. That all costs and expenses of the construction, equipping, operation and maintenance of the library and of the subject property shall be borne by the PARISH.

It is further agreed and stipulated that the property being donated herein is being donated for the construction and operation of a public library. Construction of said public library is required to begin within two years of this donation, or said property and all improvements thereon shall revert to the St. Charles Parish School Board. Should at any time in the future this property and all improvements thereon no longer be used as a public library, said property and all improvements thereon shall revert to the St. Charles Parish School Board. However, it is further agreed and stipulated that should either of the reversionary clauses contained herein be implemented, the SCHOOL BOARD shall have the right to demand of the PARISH, and the PARISH shall be obligated at its sole expense, to remediate the property and improvements thereon such that they are free of any and all potential and/or existing environmental contamination liabilities, to the reasonable satisfaction of the SCHOOL BOARD.

It is acknowledged that this donation is being made as a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement and is authorized by Article 6, Section 20 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana, The Local Services Law of the State of Louisiana, (RS

33:1321-1337) and other laws of the State of Louisiana, in order to allow St. Charles Parish to better provide the citizens of the parish with library services.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto St. Charles Parish, its successors and assigns forever.
