  - c) Vandalism organize community education programs on the effects of vandalism, supervise community service clean-up projects and helping the elderly.
  - d) Curfew and Violence monitor compliance with court order conditions of probation.
  - e) Ungovernable coordinate training for families, and monitor compliance with counseling as ordered by the court.
  - f) Runaways mandatory counseling on a regular basis.
  - g) Theft organize community education programs on the consequences of theft and supervise community service clean-up program.
- 3) Implement the grant in accordance with the rules, regulations, procedures, and guidelines of the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice applicable to Subgrant Number A98-8-028 including the submission of Quarterly Progress Reports.
- 4) Comply with all provisions of the Statement of Subgrant Award #A98-8-028 and the conditions of the Subgrant Application including all audit requirements.

5) Reimburse St. Charles Parish for any disallowed grant expenditures required to be returned to the Commission.
