A resolution authorizing the Chairman or the Secretary to offer no objection to

INTERNATIONAL MATEX TANK TERMINAL

DEQ:LPDES Permit LA0075833

BE IT RESOLVED by the St. Charles Parish Council acting as the Governing Authority of the Parish:

SECTION I. That the Chairman or the Secretary be and is hereby authorized to offer no objection in connection with the application of

INTERNATIONAL MATEX TANK TERMINAL

for a Louisiana Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (LPDES) Permit to discharge into Lake Pontchartrain via La Branche Wetlands and into the Mississippi River, treated process wastewaters, boiler blowdown, condensate, hydrostatic test wastewater and stormwater from an existing bulk liquid storage terminal located at 11842 River Road, St. Rose, ST. CHARLES PARISH.

SECTION II. That the offer of no objection shall be issued contingent upon the said

INTERNATIONAL MATEX TANK TERMINAL

their transferees and/or assigns agreeing to and complying with the provision that should changes in the conditions in the vicinity be required in the future, they will make such changes as may be necessary to satisfactorily meet the situation and shall bear the cost thereof.
