#### **SUMMARY OF AUDIT FINDINGS**


- 1. The Independent Auditors' Report expresses an unmodified ("clean") opinion that the financial statements of St. Charles Parish are presented fairly, in all material respects.

#### **GOVERNMENT FINANCE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION (GFOA) AWARD**



#### ST. CHARLES PARISH GOVERNMENT-WIDE GOVERNMENTAL NET POSITION 2017 - 2021




# ST. CHARLES PARISH PROPRIETARY FUNDS NET POSITION 2017 - 2021

**NOTE:** The Proprietary Funds consist of the Waterworks Utility System, Wastewater Utility System, and Solid Waste Collection and Disposal.


#### ST. CHARLES PARISH GENERAL FUND FUND BALANCE 2017 - 2021

# ST. CHARLES PARISH SPECIAL REVENUE FUND BALANCE 2017 - 2021






# ST. CHARLES PARISH GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS REVENUES 2017 - 2021




# ST. CHARLES PARISH GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS EXPENDITURES 2017 - 2021
