Although I am, today, petitioning to address the council at the next scheduled council meeting on June 2, 2003 as a safe guard; I request a "town hall" type meeting between the members of the council, the public works department, the planning and zoning department, any engineers which may have performed analysis and made recommendations regarding the ditch, and any members of the public which may have interest in the ditch which was dug on Country Cottage Estates, Phase 1 property owner's rear servitude. I believe that phase 2 property owner's may have an interest in this matter. Although I was not able to address the council on all the issues I had planned, I am sated, for the moment, in the fact that the matter will be reviewed. I am concerned that if a public meeting without a three minute (or even with a five minute extension) is not had on this matter, all the issues will not be fully considered. This matter could have grave ramifications if left as-is. Although safety is my primary concern, other signers of the petition submitted at the May 19,2003 council meeting are concerned about property depreciation, wrongful application of ordinances on the means for drainage, or the necessity of a swale at all. I anticipate e-mailing all a copy of the e-mail sent to Mr. Marino last week and expounding on that letter with more current information which was not had at the time that e-mail was sent.
