**WHEREAS,** it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate it; and,

**WHEREAS,** Public Law No. 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation by the President of the United States of America designating September 17<sup>th</sup> through September 23<sup>rd</sup> of each year as CONSTITUTION WEEK.


## "CONSTITUTION WEEK"




