

Interested parties are hereby notified that the Coastal Management Division of the Department of Natural Resources has received the following application for a Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49, Sections 214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program.

LOCATION: Lafourche/St. Charles Parishes, LA; approximately 14 miles northeast of Raceland, LA; Bayou Des

Allemands; Sections 37, 39, & 40; T15S-R21E; POB: Lat. 29° 45' 03", Long. 90° 22' 10"; POE: Lat.

29° 45' 07", Long. 90° 22' 29".

DESCRIPTION: Proposed installation of approximately 1,744' of one 10" flowline to be bored under Bayou Des Allemands, matted temporary work areas, and a 1,800' x 3' flotation ditch. Approximately 5 cubic vards of native material will be temporarily displaced during tie-in activities and approximately 392 cu. yds. of native material will be temporarily displaced during flotation ditch construction. Approximately 1.7 acres of water bottom habitat and approximately 0.9 acres of upland habitat may be impacted by the proposed project.**

THE APPLICANT MUST SECURE A STATE COASTAL USE PERMIT. LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION IS ALSO REQUIRED. INDEPENDENT EVALUATIONS AND DECISIONS WILL BE MADE BY THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.

Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having an interest in this permit request. Comments to the State of Louisiana, Coastal Management Division must be mailed within 25 days of the date of official journal publication of this notice to Coastal Management Division, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, P.O. box 44487, Capitol Station, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70804-4487. Comments concerning this application can be filed with the Office of Water Resources within ten days of this notice to the following address: Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Water Resources, Water Pollution Control Division, P.O. Box 82215, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70884. All comment letters should contain both the applicant is name and the appropriate application number.

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State of Louisiana Coastal Use Permit Criteria

The decision on whether dr not to issue a Coastal Use Permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts of the proposed activity in accordance with the state policies outlined in R.S. 49:214.22. The decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The decision must be consistent with the state program and approved local programs for affected parishes and must represent an appropriate balancing of social, environmental and economic factors. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among these are flood and storm hazards, water quality, water supply, feasible alternative sites, drainage patterns, historical sites, economics, public and private benefits, coastal water dependency; impacts on natural features, compatibility with the natural and cultural setting and the extent of long term benefits or adverse impacts.

Public Hearings

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. Request for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing.



Bayou Des Allemands Field





- All structures, facilities, well and pipelines/flowlines occurring in open water areas or in olifield canals or slips shall be removed within 120 days of abandonment of the facilities for the herein permitted use unless prior written approval to leave such structures in place is received from the Coastal Management Division. This condition does not preciude the necessity for revising the current permit or obtaining a separate Coastal Use Permit, should one be required, for such removal activities.
- As-built drawings shall be submitted within 30 days of completion of this
 project to the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources. Coastal Management
