An ordinance to approve and authorize the execution of Change Order No. One (1) for the Bar Screen Improvements Project to increase the contract amount by \$11,400,24.

SECTION II. That it is necessary to increase the contract amount by \$11,400.24. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL, do hereby approve and authorize the execution of Change Order No. One (1) to the contract for the Bar Screen Improvements Project, to increase the contract price by \$11,400.24; and.

Description:

Excavate and determine extent of concrete footing. Cope sheet pile to fit around existing concrete footing. Form, furnish reinforcing steel and pour a concrete support structure under existing discharge bay wing wall. Clean-out and dispose of earthen materials and miscellaneous debris from Norco New Pump Station sump.

Reason for Change Order:

Upon being exposed during construction, the existing concrete footing for the Norco New Pump Station was in direct conflict with proposed sheet pile installation for wing wall. Erosion under Norco New Pump Station discharge basin had been worsening and needed to be stopped. Debris in the pump station sump was adversely affecting pump performance.

The following are costs for the above referenced project. We have totaled all costs for the duration of the activities and then divided by four days to equal daily cost. These costs are as follows:

The prices above reflect total labor for days we worked on sheet piling and extra concrete and cleaning under exacting pump station. As discussed we estimate loosing two days. The above is for (4) days total (\$2,280.50) divided by four days = (\$570.13 per day) gives average daily cost. Then multiply times two = \$1,140.25.

We have not completed pouring concrete wall to fill void area, effected by wash out and protruding concrete footing. We estimate approximately one half a day to complete. Based upon the above cost to date we estimate completion cost for one half day of \$2,280.05, this would total \$11,400.24.

Therafore, please issue a Change Order reflecting \$11,400.24 for the extra work encountered. We hope this cost breakdown you requested will meet your needs.
