An ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinance Appendix A, Section IV General Provisions 5 Fences THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:
SECTION I. That the Code of Ordinance, Appendix A, Section IV General Provisions, 5 Fences, is herby amended as follows:
As written: A residential fence erected within the required front yard setbage may not exceed four (4) feet in height. No fence shall be erected so as to block incular travel sight lines, as defined in AASHTO (American Association of State Inchway and Transportation Official Manual). Additionally, no fence will be permitted on riner lots within twenty (20) feet of the intersection with said twenty (20) feet to be measured from the property corner along the front and side property lines.
REWRITTEN: A residential fence erected within the required out yard setback may no exceed four (4) feet in height. No fence shall be erected so at a block vehicular travel sight lines, as defined in AASHTO (American Association of Sate Highway and Transportation Official Manual). Additionally, no fence will be permitted on corner lots within twenty (20) feet of the intersection with said to (20) feet to be reasured from the property corner along the front and side property lines. If fence height shall be measured from the ground elevation to the top of the fencing the fence height measurement will include the chain wall height in cases where he fence the set atop a chain wall. Fence heights for those separating commercial uses from residential uses shall be measured from the ground elevation on the commercial side of the fence.
And the ordinance was declared adopted this day of, 2009, to become effective five (5) days after publication in the Official Journal.
