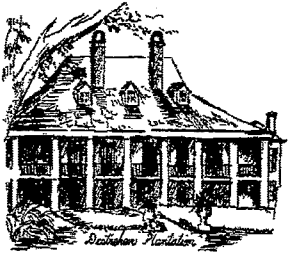


The Parish of St. Charles

IN MEMORIAM



WHEREAS, on March 23, 2025, the Almighty God, in His Infinite Wisdom, has seen fit to call from among us one of His most worthy servants, **St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Deputy Sergeant Grant Candies**; and,

WHEREAS, **Sergeant Candies**, a seven year veteran of the United States Marine Corps, and a St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Deputy since 2016, was killed in the line of duty while courageously serving his community; and,

WHEREAS, **Sergeant Candies**, was killed by a driver fleeing a traffic stop on Interstate I-10 in Slidell; Sergeant Candies deployed a spike strip to assist with stopping the vehicle pursuit when he was struck by the suspects; and,

WHEREAS, **Sergeant Candies**, was born and raised in Luling, Louisiana, and dedicated his life to law enforcement, which was inspired by his father, retired Captain Mark Candies of the St. Charles Parish Sheriff's Office, who served his community for over 30 years; and,

WHEREAS, **Sergeant Candies**, is the fifth deputy to give his life in the line of duty since the formation of the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS, **Sergeant Candies**, is survived by his loving wife Courtney, cherished children Brenna and Bryson, and his parents Mark Candies and Bettye Jean Freeman.
