An ordinance to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement by and between St. Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District for the continued funding of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Constitution and the Local Service Law of Louisiana allow for Intergovernmental agreements among the political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish, in conjunction with the Lafourche Basin Levee District has been working on the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee; and,

WHEREAS, construction has recently begun on Phase I of the Levee; and, WHEREAS, the current cost estimate to continue this project is \$500,000.00.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Intergovernmental Agreement, State of Louisiana, Parish of St. Charles, by and between St. Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District is hereby approved.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of St. Charles Parish.
