An ordinance to revoke and abandon an undeveloped unnamed right-of-way adjacent to American Legion Post 366 in Destrehan.

WHEREAS, since the dedication, the property presently has no public use and/or benefit; and.

WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Council desires to revoke said property as provided by law unto the River Road Veterans Club, Inc., the present record owner of adjacent properties.
