Interested parties are hereby notified that the Coastal Management Division of the Department of Natural Resources has received the following application for a Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49, Sections 214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program.

NAME: Koch Industries; c/o T. Baker Smith & Son, Inc.; Attn: David Martinez; P. O. Box 2266; Houma, LA 70361;

LOCATION: St. Charles Parish, LA: Flowline P.O.B. - Lat. 30°01'03"N, Long. 90°19'59"W, P.O.E. - Lat. 30°00'24"N, Long. 90°20'06"W; T12S-R9E; near Lake Pontchartrain;

DESCRIPTION: The proposed activity consists of the lowering of an existing 16" pipeline. Approx. 6,670 cubic yards of water bottom material will be displaced as the pipeline is lowered in a 4,000' x 10' trench. Spoil resulting from the excavation will be placed adjacent to the trench, and later used as backfill. No marsh will be affected as a result of these activities. The access route for the marsh buggy will be conducted through the existing ditch. Approx. 1.86 acres of water bottom habitat will be impacted as a result of this project.**

^{**}Habitat impacts are based on available in-house data and may not represent actual conditions. Field reconnaissance may be required to verify extent of impacts.

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THE APPLICANT MUST SECURE A STATE COASTAL USE PERMIT. LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION IS ALSO REQUIRED. INDEPENDENT EVALUATIONS AND DECISIONS WILL BE MADE BY THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY.

Plans for the proposed work are now on file and may be inspected at the office of the Coastal Management Division, Department of Natural Resources, State Land and Natural Resources Building, 625 North 4th Street; Room 1011, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 504/342-7591. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having an interest in this permit request. Comments to the State of Louisiana, Coastal Management Division must be mailed within 25 days of the date of official journal publication of this notice to Coastal Management Division, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, P.O. box 44487, Capitol Station, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70804-4487. 
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
State of Louisiana Coastal Use Permit Criteria


The decision on whether or not to issue a Coastal Use Permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts of the proposed activity in accordance with the state policies outlined in R.S. 49:214.22. The decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The decision must be consistent with the state program and approved local programs for affected parishes and must represent an appropriate balancing of social, environmental and economic factors. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among these are flood and storm hazards, water quality, water supply, feasible alternative sites, drainage patterns, historical sites, economics, public and private benefits, coastal water dependency, impacts on natural features, compatibility with the natural and cultural setting and the extent of long term benefits or adverse impacts.


Public Hearings



- 1. TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL PARTIES, THE LA. ONE CALL SYSTEM SHALL BE CONTACTED A MIN. OF 48 HRS. PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF ANY EXCAVATION.
- 2. AS-BUILT DRAWINGS SHALL BE SUBMITTED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF COMPLETION OF THIS PROJECT TO THE LA. DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, PIPELINE DIVISION AND THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION.
- 3. ALL STRUCTURES, FACILITIES, WELL AND PIPELINES/FLOWLINES SHALL BE REMOVED WITHIN 120 DAYS OF ABANDONMENT OF THE FACILITIES FOR THE HEREIN PERMITTED USE UNLESS PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL TO LEAVE SUCH STRUCTURES IN PLACE IS RECEIVED FROM THE COASTAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION. THIS CONDITION DOES NOT PRECLUDE THE NECESSITY FOR REVISING THE CURRENT PERMIT OR OBTAINING A SEPARATE COASTAL USE PERMIT, SHOULD ONE BE REQUIRED, FOR SUCH REMOVAL ACTIVITIES.
- 4. ALL SPOIL GENERATED DURING EXCAVATION/DREDGING WILL BE RETURNED TO THE AREA FROM WHICH IT WAS REMOVED UPON COMPLETION OF PROPOSED ACTIVITIES.
