

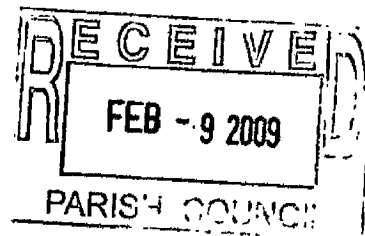

ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMUNITY BOUNDARIES

FOR ST. CHARLES PARISH

There are no incorporated municipalities in St. Charles Parish. However, there are numerous communities which have individual identities tied to different periods of growth during the history of the Parish. The U. S. Census Bureau identifies many of the communities as Census Designated Places (CDPs). Demographics are generated for each of these CDPs after every decennial census. Many of the communities grew around post offices and each of these has its own zip code. Others share zip codes with adjacent communities. Establishment of the 911 emergency telephone system has required the use of municipal numbers to correctly identify locations. Assigning of the addresses has sometimes conflicted with the designation given by the U. S. Postal Service. ~~As the Parish has grown, many of the old boundaries that once identified the beginning and ending of a community have disappeared.~~ Growth of one community next to another has created much confusion in trying to correctly assign addresses. In order to set the record straight and to ensure everyone is using the same community name for a given area, St. Charles Parish has determined it would be of public interest to provide official legal descriptions for each community within the Parish. Thus all parties concerned in the delivery of services will be using the same boundaries.

In order to accomplish this task, South Central Planning and Development Commission proposes to undertake the following Scope of Service.

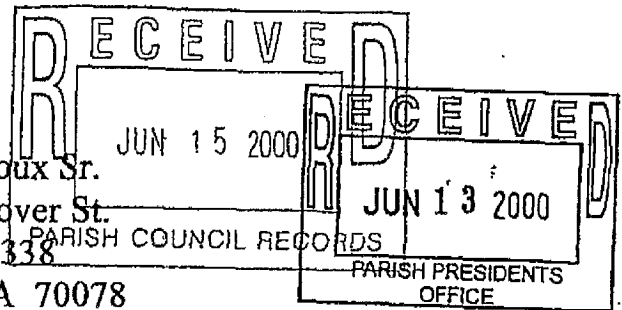

Is there a local conspiracy to do in these two small towns by the Post Office and the 911 Commission?

~~Statement – Folks is Montz, Louisiana even though they also are not listed on the Official State Map;~~



Recently received my Census Bureau form to fill out and guess what address it was sent to – yes – Destrehan, La. I have never used Destrehan as my address – so where did they get that info?

Persons living on my street; if they do not have a post office box but receive their mail at the street have to use a Destrehan address – with which I thoroughly disagree.

Would not it be just as easy to use the correct address such as Route 1, New Sarpy, La?

~~It might this be reprehensible to our friends in the new more prestigious neighborhoods for them to say they live in this little town which began more than 70 years ago??~~

There are a number of new subdivisions in this town – even up to Schexnayder Lane and beyond – and can anyone give me a percentage of those persons who do not have a post office box and thereby must use the Destrehan address?? When these families submitted their census sheets what town did they use

And how will the Census Bureau ever determine the true number of persons living in my hometown??

I know of some businesses for years have used the Destrehan address; only because it is easier for them to have their mail delivered to their front door and it was made necessary by the Post Office.

For some time I was supposed to write your office to determine how does an un-incorporated town be listed and shown on the "Official" state Map. Is it due to size of population? Nope - can't be that as I checked on computer three towns in La Salle Parish had less number of residents. Those towns are Tullos - 1995 population of 453; Urania - 792; Olla with 1508 and even Jena had a count of 2646. According to computer info NEW SARPY, LA. HAD POPULATION OF 2,946 IN 1990. And was on prior maps.

Could your "official" map have been produced by the same company who made one for a local area telephone "yellow pages" some years ago? Nope - the one I have was made in Kentucky while the phone Co. map was out of Colorado. On that map New Sarpy was not listed or shown but the streets were shown as being in Destrehan or Norco; which are on either side. After they were notified the error was corrected - but did they at least drop me a line to admit mistake? No way Jose. Only those who never do anything can live without doing something wrong - but at least those of us who do - can also own up to an error or something being overlooked.

Were there any other towns in the State that might have been left off? Are all of the parishes contacted before publication to determine if any places were left off?

To some my complaint may seem to be unwarranted - but on this Veteran's Day - I would like to point out that I am 68 years old and have lived in New Sarpy, Louisiana for all of those years except for the two years I spent in the US Army. This town had that name before I was born and continues to be that as of today. We do have Post Office 70078; although some persons who get their mail curbside use a Destrehan, LA. address.

Hope to receive some feedback on this matter. Know that New Sarpy still exists because I had my own real estate company for over 20 years - right here in this large metropolis.

I run my Army Reunion Group and if any of my buddies look me up on our "official" map they will never find me.
