**RESOLUTION NO. 5925**

A resolution to request that the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development designate Apple Street in Norco as a "No Hazardous Cargo" route.

**WHEREAS,** Apple Street in Norco, which is a section of LA 48, is utilized by numerous trucks transporting Hazardous Cargo to nearby industrial facilities; and,

**WHEREAS,** since improvements have been made to accommodate oversize vehicles in the area of the industrial facilities along LA 48 in Norco; it is no longer necessary for said vehicles to travel down Apple Street; and,

**WHEREAS,** said vehicles can instead utilize Prospect Avenue, LA 627, to access local industrial facilities; and,

**WHEREAS,** Prospect Avenue (LA 627) is in an industrial area and more appropriate for the transportation of Hazardous Cargo; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL,** do hereby request that the Louisiana Department of Transportation & Development designate Apple Street in Norco as a "No Hazardous Cargo" route and direct all hazardous cargo to use Prospect Avenue (LA 627).
