ORDINANCE NO. 04-9-10

An ordinance approving and authorizing the establishment of a Home Occupation under the operation of Karen & Dee Fedrick – "Sno-Biz" – a stationary and mobile snowball stand at 421 Barton Avenue, Luling, La.

**WHEREAS,** the St. Charles Parish Code, Appendix A, Section XXII requires both Planning and Zoning Commission and Council approval for those home occupations requiring a state agency review for such operations; and,

**WHEREAS,** the proposed home occupation of Karen & Dee Fedrick would require Louisiana State licensing for a snowball stand.

**THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION I.** That the described home occupation application by Karen & Dee Fedrick, 421 Barton Avenue, Luling, La is for – "Sno-Biz" –stationary and mobile snowball stand is hereby approved.

**SECTION II.** That the Department of Planning & Zoning is hereby authorized to grant Karen & Dee Fedrick a home occupation permit for a snowball stand.
