Interested parties are hereby notified that the Coastal Management Division of the Department of Natural Resources has received the following application for a Coastal Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with the State and Local Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R S.49, Sections 214 21-214.41), and the rules and regulation of the Coastal Resources Program

Application has also been made to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P L, 95-217)

NAME: Mr. Eugene N. Belanger; 4321 Illinois Ave.; Kenner, LA 70065;

LOCATION: St. Charles Parish, LA, Section 40, T12S-R9E, Lots 61, 62, 63, and 64 of Almeida Plantation Subdivision on Hwy. 61, Lat 29° 58′ 18″ N, Long. 90° 18′ 29″ W;

DESCRIPTION: Proposed construction of a structure to use as a restaurant. Approx. 13,357 cu. yds. of sand/soil will be used to elevate the property to a grade that satisfies St. Charles Parish guidelines. Approx. 1.14 acres of bottomland hardwood and marsh will be impacted by the project.**

State of Louisiana Coastal Use Permit Criteria

Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having an interest in this permit request. Comments to the State of Louisiana, Coastal Management Division must be received within 25 days of the date of official journal publication of this notice. All comment letters should contain both the applicant's name and the appropriate application number and should be mailed to the Coastal Management Division, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, P.O. The decision on whether or not to issue a Coastal Use Permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts of the proposed activity in accordance with the state policies outlined in R.S. 49:214.22. The decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The decision must be consistent with the state program and approved local programs for affected parishes and must represent an appropriate balancing of social, environmental and economic factors. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among these are flood and storm hazards, water quality, water supply, feasible alternative sites, drainage patterns, historical sites, economics, public and private benefits, coastal water dependency, impacts on natural features, compatibility with the natural and cultural setting and the extent of long term benefits or adverse impacts.

State of Louisiana Water Quality Certification Criteria

In accordance with the Joint Public Notice Agreement between Coastal Management Division and the Office of Water Resources, notice is hereby given that the applicant has applied to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and provision of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.L. 95-217)

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
