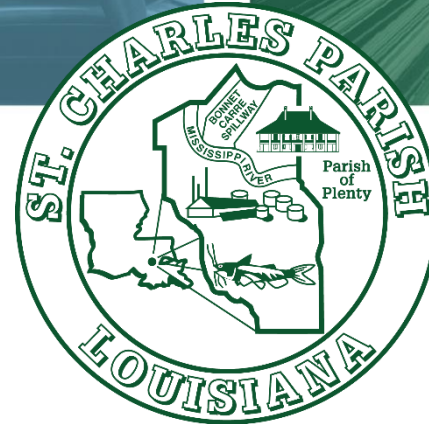

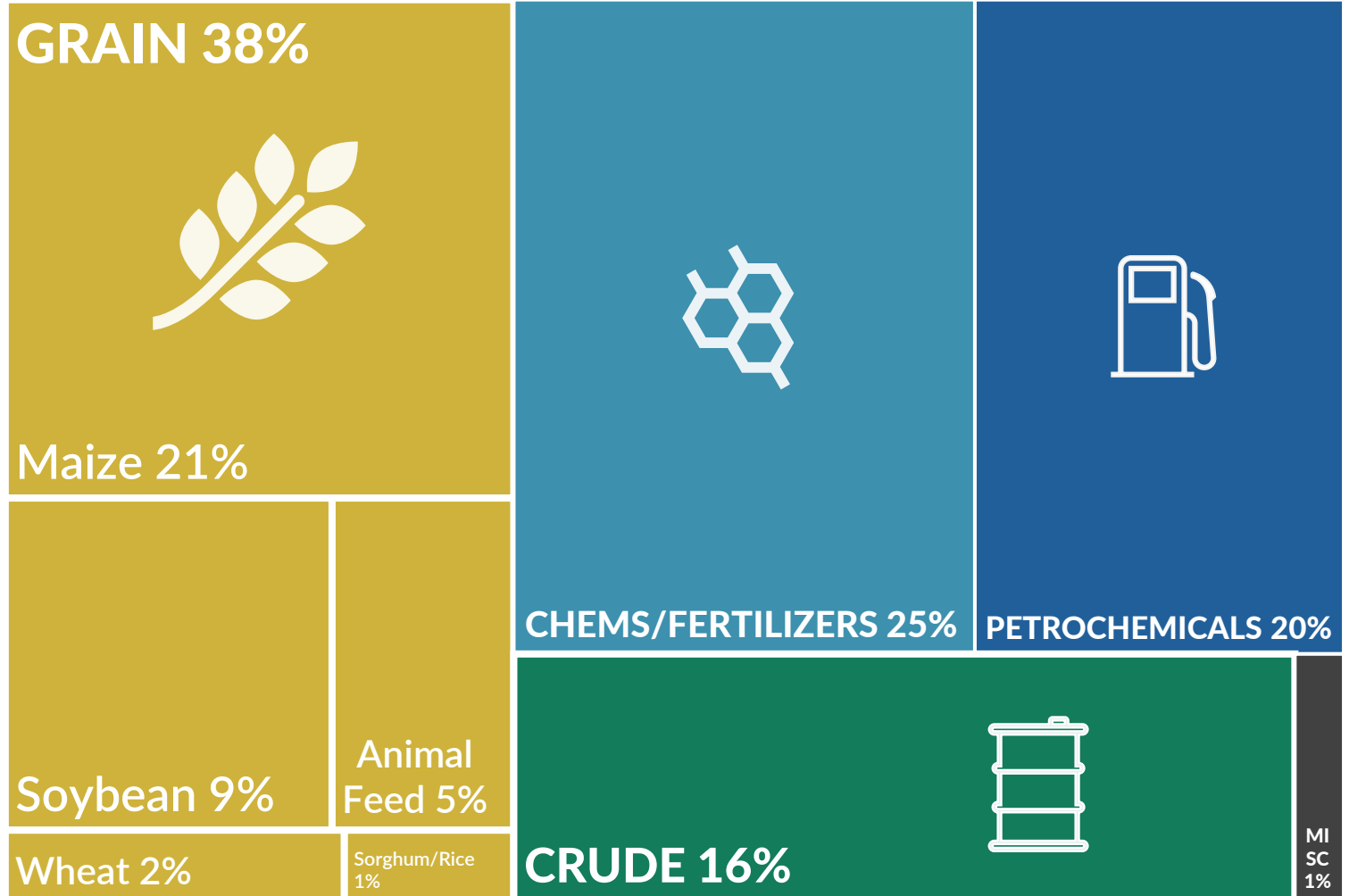
COMMODITY BREAKDOWN [IN TONS, 2025]

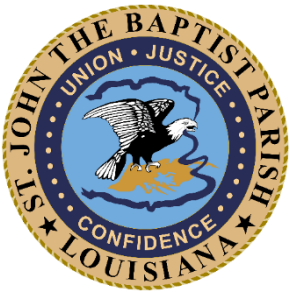
- \$5.8B ultra-low carbon steel plant in Ascension Parish
- Port of South Louisiana to build deep water dock
- Imports: 3.6M tons of iron ore
- Exports: 2.7M tons of coils to Hyundai plants around the U.S.
