An ordinance to revoke and abandon Modoc Street, and portions of Jonathan Street, Pelican Street, Amie Street, Jean Street, and Destrehan Park Subdivision, as shown on the map by Michael P. Blanchard, PLS, signed and dated February 5, 2024.

WHEREAS, Modoc Street, and portions of Jonathan Street (Destrehan), Pelican Street (St. Charles), Amie Street, and Jean Street were developed as part of Destrehan Park Subdivision as shown on the map by Clifford G. Webb, CE, dated November 23, 1951, revised August 26, 1952, and statutorily dedicated therein to public ownership and accepted therein by the President of the St. Charles Parish Police Jury; and,

WHEREAS, the lots fronting the portions of the streets to be revoked have since been acquired by Bunge North America Inc./Bunge Corporation/Bunge Chevron

Ag Renewables LLC; and,

WHEREAS, the properties are in Destrehan Park Subdivision and are owned by Bunge North America Inc. (successor to Bunge Corporation) and Bunge Chevron Ag Renewables LLC; and,

WHEREAS, as per Chapter 2, Article I, Section 2-4 of the St. Charles Parish Code of Ordinances, Bunge North America Inc. and Bunge Chevron AG Renewables have requested the revocation of Modoc Street, and portions of Jonathan Street, Pelican Street, Amie Street, and Jean Street as shown on the map by Michael P. Blanchard, PLS, signed and dated February 5, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the revocation at its regular meeting on March 7, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Council wishes to revoke said property pursuant to Chapter 2, Article I, Section 2-4 of the Code of Ordinances, as said property is no longer needed for public purposes.

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That all of the St. Charles Parish rights, title, and interest in and to Modoc Street, and those portions of Jonathan Street, Pelican Street, Amie Street, Jean Street, and Destrehan Park Subdivision, as shown on the map by Michael P. Blanchard, PLS, signed and dated February 5, 2024, are hereby revoked.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute an Act of Revocation in favor of adjacent property owners, and such other agreements and instruments as the Parish President deems necessary to carry out the intent of this

ordinance.

BEFORE the undersigned Notaries Public, duly commissioned and qualified in and for the Parish and State aforesaid, therein residing, and in the presence of the two competent witnesses hereinafter named and undersigned,

PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED;

ST. CHARLES PARISH (**-***1208), a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, herein represented by Matthew Jewell, its Parish President, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, LA 70057; authorized pursuant to Ordinance No. 24-4-3 adopted by St. Charles Parish Council on the 12 day of April, 2024, a certified copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof;

APPEARER declared unto me, Notary, as follows:

In the dedication contained in the plat map for the Destrehan Park Subdivision (that plat map being made by Hotard & Webb, Civil Engineers on November 23, 1951, approved and accepted by the Police Jury of St. Charles Parish, and filed in the public records of the Clerk of Court of St. Charles Parish) (the "Destrehan Park Plat Map"), the roadbeds and streets in the Destrehan Park Subdivision, including Jonathan Street (depicted on the Destrehan Park Plat Map as "Destrehan Street"), Modoc Street, Pelican Street (depicted on the Destrehan Park Plat Map as "St. Charles Street"), Amie Street, and Jean Street were dedicated to and accepted by St. Charles Parish as public streets bearing the dimensions set out on the Destrehan Park Plat Map.

Since the dedication and construction of the streets in the Destrehan Park Subdivision and until recently, Jonathan Street, Modoc Street, Pelican Street, Amie Street, and Jean Street have been used and maintained by St. Charles Parish as public streets. Due to a change in the use of the property adjacent thereto, Jonathan Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Modoc Street (in its entirety), Pelican Street (that portion depicted on the attached

Plan of Revocation), Amie Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), and Jean Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation) no longer serve a public function and are no longer needed for public use.

The landowners adjoining these streets and portions thereof are as follows (the "Adjoining Landowners"): Bunge Chevron Ag Renewables LLC and Bunge North America, Inc.

Because these streets no longer serve a public function, the Adjoining Landowners have requested and the Parish of St. Charles has agreed to revoke the dedication of and abandon all of its rights, title, and interests in and to Jonathan Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Modoc Street (in its entirety), Pelican Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Amie Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), and Jean Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation).

By operation of law, upon the revocation of these streets, ownership of the property underlying the right-of-way for these streets will transfer to the adjacent landowners. The property is depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation, by Acadia Land Surveying, LLC (the "Revocation Plat") and the attached Plan of Resubdivision, by Acadia Land Surveying, LLC (the "Resubdivision Plat").

The present dimensions of portions of the streets and portions thereof which are being revoked are as follows:

Because it has been determined by St. Charles Parish that these streets no longer serve a public purpose and that it is in the best interest of St. Charles Parish to revoke the dedication of and abandon all of its rights in and to these streets, in accordance with La. R. S. 48:701:

Matthew Jewell, Parish President, duly authorized by virtue of Ordinance No. 24-4-3 of the St. Charles Parish Council adopted on April 1, 2024, a certified copy of which is annexed hereto and made part hereof, does hereby revoke the dedication of and abandon all of its rights, title, and interests in and to Jonathan Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Modoc Street (in its entirety), Pelican Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Amie Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), and Jean Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation). Without any warranty whatsoever, but with full substitution and subrogation in and to all the rights and actions of warranty which it has or may have, the said St. Charles Parish does hereby convey, transfer, assign, set over, abandon and quitclaim all of its rights, title and interests, and further waives and releases in favor of the Adjoining Landowners all rights to use the surface of the property associated with oil, gas, and other minerals and for any and all related mineral operations and production, in and to Jonathan Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Modoc Street (in its entirety), Pelican Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of

Revocation), Amie Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Jean Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation) and, for avoidance of doubt, the land covered by and embraced in the streets, as follows, in accordance with and as directed by the provisions of La. R. S. 48:701:

TO BUNGE CHEVRON AG RENEWABLES, LLC, those portions of Jonathan Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Modoc Street (in its entirety), Pelican Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), Amie Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), and Jean Street (that portion depicted on the attached Plan of Revocation), that are incorporated into Parcel P1-A as depicted on the Resubdivision Plat, and more fully described as:


