That pursuant to the above recited ordinance, the Parish of St. Charles does
hereby abandon and revoke the following described servitude:
Two (2) ten-foot Servitudes for Sewer Force Main and one (1) 75' by 30' Servitude for Sewer Treatment Plant located on Lot X-1-A, granted unto St. Charles Parish in an Act of Dedication dated August 22, 1984 by Babe's Construction, Inc to St. Charles Parish, recorded in C.O.B 323, Folio 448, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana. The location of the said servitudes are more fully described on the attached survey by Lucier C. Gassen, dated November 26, 1990, attached hereto and made a par of.
The revocation of the servitudes described above are hereby deemed to be in the

BE IT KNOWN, that Paul J. Hogan, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 250, Des Allemands, Louisiana 70030, hereinafter referred to as GRANTOR, personally came and appeared. GRANTOR does hereby grant a ten (10) foot permanent sewer force main servitude to St. Charles Parish, a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana, whose address is P. O. Box 302, Hahnville, Louisiana, 70057, (hereinafter referred to as GRANTEE) for the purposes of constructing, installing, operating, maintaining, repairing and/or replacing a sewer force main under the following described property situated in St. Charles Parish, to-wit:

Property:

A permanent sewer force main servitude located across the rear of Lot X-1-A1 of Dixieland Subdivision, Montz, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, consisting of a strip of land Ten (10) feet in width adjacent to and parallel to the rear of said lot.

The location of the permanent sewer servitude is more fully described on the attached survey by Lucien C. Gassen, dated \_\_\_\_\_\_, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Permanent structures are prohibited on the said servitude. The granting of this servitude shall not restrict the **GRANTOR** from constructing a fence within the said servitude. Should the **GRANTEE** have to remove any part of a fence for construction and/or repair of the sewer main and associated improvements, the **GRANTEE** will repair or replace the fence. The premises so disturbed by the installation, maintenance, and or repair of the sewer force main shall be reasonably restored to its original condition by the **GRANTEE**.

This permanent servitude is being granted for the purposes of constructing and maintaining a sewer force main and GRANTOR grants unto GRANTEE the right of ingress and egress to and from said servitude for the purpose of installation, construction, operation, maintenance, repairing and inspection of said sewer force main. GRANTOR retains the rights to fully use and enjoy the above-described property, except as to the rights here and above granted. GRANTEE agrees to indemnify and hold harmless GRANTOR from any and all damages which GRANTOR may suffer, caused either wholly or in part, by reason of the negligence of the Parish, its agents or employees, in the installation, operation or maintenance of the sewer force main.

To have and to hold said servitude unto the said GRANTEE, its successors and assigns until said servitude is exercised and so long thereafter as the same shall be useful for the above named purposes.
