




2020 Accomplishments


- BCEGS Rating:

For the past 4 years, St. Charles Parish has held the Chairperson's seat on the Building Code Construction Council.














Coastal Zone

- St. Charles's Local Coastal Program
 went into effect late in 2017. Since
 then the Local Program has been able
 to process 10 permits locally. This is
 keeping decisions local rather than out
 of Baton Rouge.
- Permits have included everything from a single family home to expansions of local industry.
- The contract with the State of Louisiana will be up for renewal before July 2019.



Coastal Zone: Floodplain Management

St. Charles Parish's modeling effort is complete and has been delivered by modelling contractor Lonnie G. Harper and Associates. Preliminary results were presented to the Hurricane Protection Projects Committee of the St. Charles Parish Council on January 22, 2019. The model, which is much better for St. Charles than the latest FEMA model is being packaged for presentation to FEMA.

NFIP 2017 Re Authorization has once again been delayed in Washington. It is currently still operating with 6 month extension that expired May 31, 2019.

The latest news from the NFIP is a proposal to rate all structures individually rather than by Floodplain Map has been all over the news lately, but few details have been released, so we cannot evaluate its effect on premiums.
