**RESOLUTION NO. 5782**

A resolution requesting the assistance and support of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development in the priority construction projects of St. Charles Parish.

**WHEREAS,** the Parish Council firmly believes the following listed issues are priority projects, which will benefit all of the citizens of St. Charles Parish:

- **Relocation of LA 3060 (Barton Avenue) to a new State route from US 90 to LA 18 at Willowdale Boulevard**
- **Widen LA 50 - Almedia Road, St. Rose from LA 48 to US 61**
- **Construct Center Turn Lane on US 90 from Maryland Drive to Coronado Drive West and Reduce Speed Limit**
- **Construct a Center Turn Lane on US 90 through Paradis**
- **Construct a Center Turn Lane on LA 48 from Ormond Plantation to I-310**
- **Install Traffic Control Signal at the intersection of LA 626 and US 61**

**WHEREAS,** the Parish Council is requesting that the Department of Transportation and Development work with St. Charles Parish in accomplishing these projects.
