**ORDINANCE NO. 11-3-2**

An ordinance to approve and authorize the execution of Change Order No. 1 for the Paradis Library located at 307 Audubon Street in Paradis.

**WHEREAS,** the St. Charles Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. 10-4-16 on April 19, 2010 approving and authorizing the execution of a contract with Lamar Contractors, Inc. for the construction of the Paradis Library at 307 Audubon Street in Paradis; and,

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to adjust the original contract to reflect those items more fully described in Change Order No. 1, said adjustment as recommended by Chenevert Architects, LLC, to increase the dollar amount by \$4,569.17 (of which Chenevert will reimburse the Parish for Item No. 1 in the amount of \$2,842.79) and increase the Contract Time by 31 days; and,

**WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Parish Council to approve said Change Order No. 1.

**THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:**

**SECTION I.** That Change Order No. 1 for the Paradis Library in the amount of a \$4,569.17 increase and an increase of thirty-one days is hereby approved.

**SECTION II.** That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said Change Order No. 1 on behalf of St. Charles Parish.
