ORDINANCE NO. 01-5-17

An Ordinance to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement by and between St Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District for the continued funding of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Constitution and the Local Service Law of Louisiana allow for Intergovernmental agreements among political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana, and,

WHEREAS, St Charles Parish, in conjunction with the Lafourche Basin Levee District has been working on the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee, and,

WHEREAS, the Parish has continued to submit additional data, including applications, land surveys, ownership information, topographic surveys, archaeological surveys, environmental surveys, geotechnical investigations, engineering, etc., and,

WHEREAS, the current cost estimate to continue this project is \$500,000.00

THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I. That the Intergovernmental Agreement, State of Louisiana, Parish of St Charles, by and between St. Charles Parish and the Lafourche Basin Levee District is hereby approved.

SECTION II. That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of St Charles Parish

**INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
STATE OF LOUISIANA

BE IT KNOWN that on this 7th day of June, 2001

PERSONALLY CAME AND APPEARED:

ST. CHARLES PARISH, 15045 River Road, P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, Louisiana 70057, herein represented by Albert D. Laque, Parish President

AND

THE LAFOURCHE BASIN LEVEE DISTRICT, 21380 Highway 20, P.O. Box 670, Vacherie, Louisiana 70090, Herein represented by Aubrey Gravois, President

who declare that they enter into this agreement.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Constitution and the Local Services Law of Louisiana allow for intergovernmental agreements among political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana; and,

WHEREAS, St. Charles Parish, in conjunction with the Lafourche Basin Levee District has been working on the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Parish Council to continue the permitting process; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Lafourche Basin Levee District to provide funding up to \$ 500,000.00 toward the Levee Project.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:


ST. CHARLES PARISH:

- 1) Shall proceed with the permits, servitude's, surveys, geotechnical investigation and engineering of the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee.
- 2) Shall select and employ the necessary persons to perform said work.
- 3) Shall invoice the Lafourche Basin Levee District for reimbursement of all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 500,000 00


THE LAFOURCHE BASIN LEVEE DISTRICT:

- 1) Hereby agrees to allocate \$ 500,000.00 to the West Bank Hurricane Protection Levee project for the purpose stated.
- 2) Shall reimburse St. Charles Parish for all expenses incurred in said project, up to the maximum of \$ 500,000.00, upon being invoiced by St. Charles Parish.
