RE: Solid Waste Cart Audit Notice

Dear Current Resident,

Pelican Waste & Debris has performed the annual cart audit as per the solid waste contract between St. Charles Parish and Pelican Waste. Per the contract, each residential home is allotted one garbage cart container supplied by the solid waste provider and billed one (1) garbage unit charge of \$16.69 on the St. Charles parish water bill. Residents may request additional cart containers through Pelican Waste and be billed an additional garbage charge per cart serviced at each residence.

The house cart audit verified this residential address has <u>2</u> cart containers. Residents may keep the additional cart(s) and be billed monthly for the appropriate number of carts, or call our office at **985-331-5191** to have the additional cart picked up. The deadline for returning any unwanted cart containers is December 30, 2019. All residents with additional cart containers will be billed based off of the annual cart audit starting January 1, 2020.

Residents may purchase their own garbage cart containers of any type and continue to put additional carts out for service. Pelican Waste & Debris will not be responsible for damaged or missing personal cart containers.

It is our understanding the previous solid waste provider did not perform their house cart audits and residents may have had more than one cart for several years. We will work with residents to make the transition as smooth as possible.
