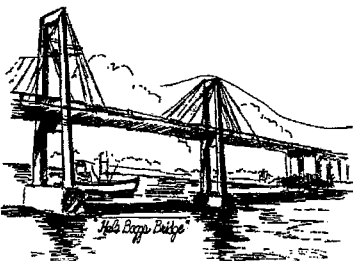
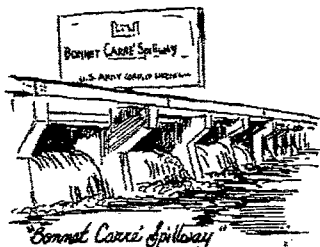
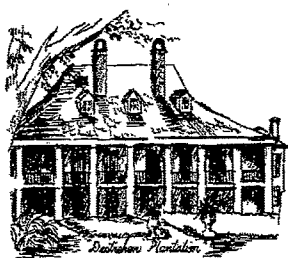


The Parish of St. Charles

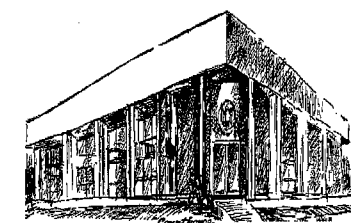
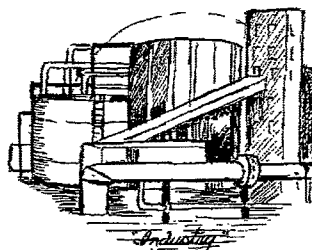
