**ORDINANCE NO.** 05-6-11

An ordinance to approve Amendment No. 1 to Easement No. DACW29-2-95-08, the Department of the Army Permit for the Engineers Canal Pump Station, to authorize the installation of a bypass culvert in Engineers Canal, Norco.

- WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. 95-9-14 on September 18, 1995 approving Department of Army Easement No. DACW29-2-95-08 for the Engineers Canal Pump Station located at 981 West Pine Street in Norco; and,
- WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has proposed to install a sixty-inch (60") corrugated metal bypass culvert to help move water through Engineers Canal past the pump station, to the Bayou Trepagnier Pump Station; and,
- WHEREAS, the Department of Army Corps of Engineers has prepared Amendment No. 1 to the original Easement agreement to allow said culvert installation; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Parish Council to approve said Amendment No. 1. THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION I.** That Amendment No. 1 to Easement No. DACW29-2-95-08 is hereby approved.

**SECTION II.** That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute said Amendment on behalf of St. Charles Parish.

# AMENDMENT NO. 1 EASEMENT NO. DACW29-2-95-08

WHEREAS, on August 29, 1995, Easement No. DACW29-2-95-08, was entered into between the Government, as Grantor, and St. Charles Parish Council, as Grantee, to construct, use, maintain, control, operate and repair a stormwater pump station along Engineer's Canal, including two 26-inch pipelines across the Bonnet Carre Spillway lower guide levee at approximate levee station 69+84, and a discharge swale inside the spillway, within our Bonnet Carre Spillway Project, in Section 5, Township 12 South, Range 8 East, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, a modification of said easement is desirable for the improvement of drainage in the area.

NOW THEREFORE, said easement is hereby amended to add on Page 1, first paragraph, a sixty-inch (60") corregated metal bypass culvert to help move water through Engineers Canal past the pump station, under Airline Highway (U.S. Highway 61), and into the newly-constructed Bayou Trepagnier pump station on the north side of Highway 61, and to reflect the location of the bypass culvert in Section 5, Township 12 South, Range 8 East, St. Charles Parish, Louisiana, subject to the condition below:

St. Charles Parish and/or its agent will perform all work in accordance with the plans and specifications stated on the enclosed Exhibit A, Drawings 1 and 2 of 2, prepared by Shread-Kuyrkendall and Associates, Inc., which includes the provision that backfill material shall be compacted to the same density as the existing material.

All other terms and conditions of the original easement remain unchanged.


