Partial funding should be provided by STAG funding anticipated by mid — January 2003. The Administration may make modifications to the preceding tasks and funding as needed, but not to exceed the total funding allocated.

AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES

Add Paragraphs 2.1.6 and 2.1.7 to Section 2.1 to read as follows:

- 2.1.6 The Project to be initiated after December 31, 2002 to fulfill the Comprehensive Written Corrective Action Plan submitted by St. Charles Parish in response to EPA Administrative Order Docket No. CWA-06-2003-1758 shall in general consist of Design and Construction Management of the following major elements:
 - a. CMOM compliance activities to include lift station evaluation and evaluation of necessary upgrades to the Parish's existing Management Information System (MIS) to further compliance with GASB 34 and CMOM.
 - Bank Pump Station and Force Main Improvements
 - c. Correctional Facility and Killona Pump Stations Force Main Extension
 - d. Improvements to the Hahnville WWTP to include:
 - new headworks
 - ii new splitter box
 - iii new ultraviolet disinfection system
 - iv new blowers and aeration diffusiors
 - Capacity to treat average daily flows for moderate population projections through 2020 as defined by the 1997 Facility Plan and 2000 Census.
 - e. Luling Oxidation Pond Pump Station and improvements to convert it to a flow equalization basin.
 - f. Study to establish projected population growth on the West Bank of St. Charles and necessary pump station and force main improvements necessary to service this growth
- 2.1.7 ENGINEER shall pursue additional Federal and Sate funding accounts to include, but not be limited to the Lake Pontchartrain Restoration Act, Capital Outlay, USCOE Environmental Infrastructure Section 219 and State and Tribal Assistance Grants (STAG) on behalf of the OWNER.

Add Paragraph 4.6 and 4.7 to Section 4 to read as follows:

4.6 The fee for the project to be initiated after December 31, 2002 and as described in Paragraph 2.1.6 shall be as follows:

CMOM Compliance	\$100,000
Design Engineering	\$580,250
Engineering Services During Construction	\$160,000

The Administration may make modifications to these tasks and funding as needed with the total funding not to exceed \$1,780,850. Supplemental services for surveying, soil testing, permitting, or other services shall be based upon a lump sum fee agreeable to both the OWNER and ENGINEER.

4.7 Engineer shall implement all projects for which a Federal or State Grant was obtained under Section 2.1.7 for a lump sum fee agreeable to both the OWNER and ENGINEER or as defined in the grant obtained.

Change sixth paragraph section 7.0 to read as follows:

7.6 This agreement shall be extended to December 31, 2006.
