Debris Removal

DEBRIS SEPARATION



VEGETATIVE DEBRIS
Tree branches, leaves, logs, plants.



HAZARDOUS WASTE
Oil, battery, pesticide, paint, cleaning supplies, compressed gas.



CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS
Building materials, drywall, lumber, carpet, furniture, plumbing.



LARGE APPLIANCES
Refrigerator, washer/dryer, air conditioner, stove, water heater, dishwasher
(Do not leave doors unsealed or unsecured).



ELECTRONICS
Television, computer, stereo, phone.



**HURRICANE

Do not place debris **near or on trees, poles or other structures**. This includes fire hydrants and meters.

MORNING ACTIONS

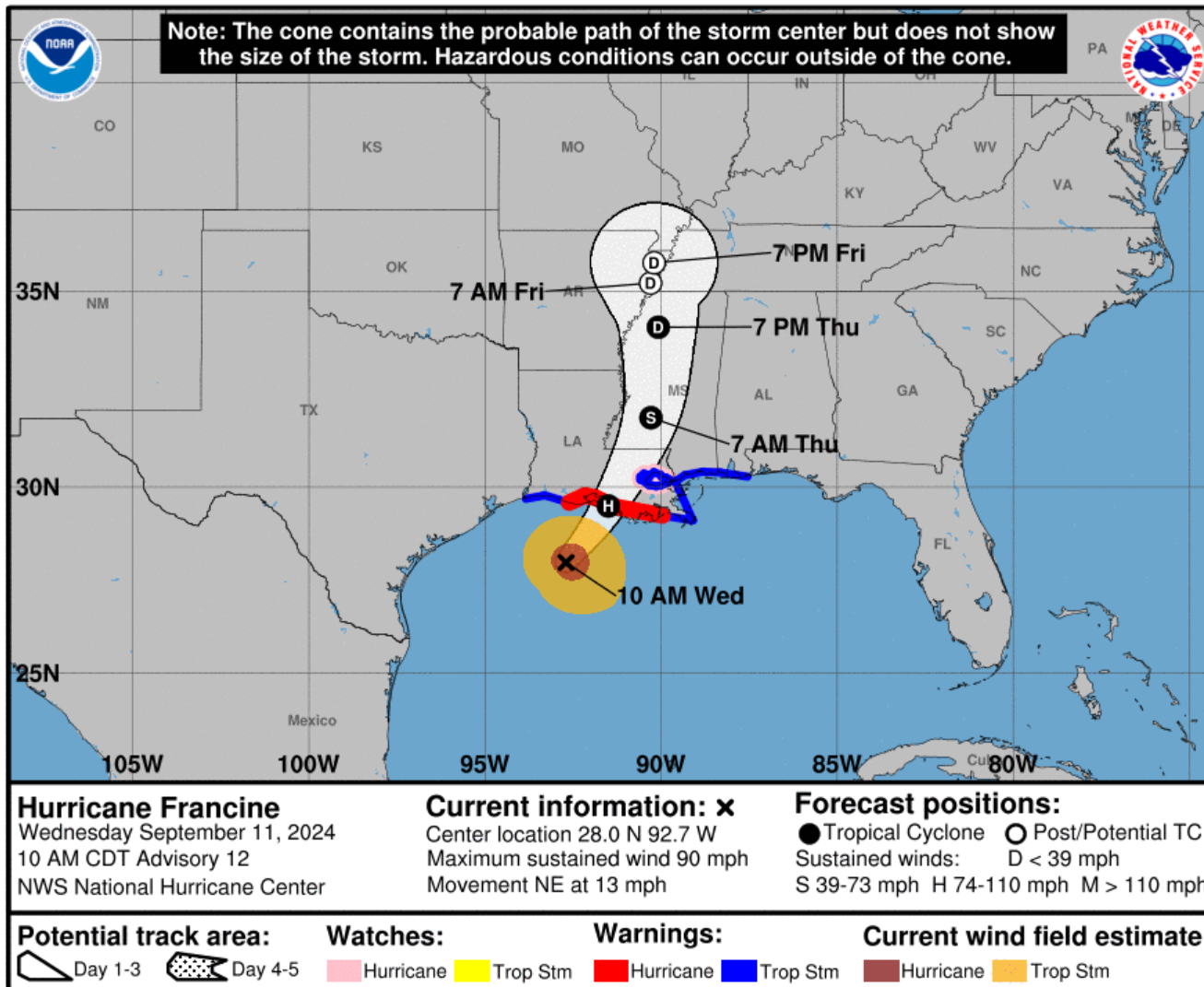
Fully Activated EOC.

Shelter of Last Resort opened at 7am.

All flood gates and boat launches were closed.

Francine predicted to:

- Land at Category 1
- Move fast (13-15mph)
- Drop heavy rain (6"-9" over the day)

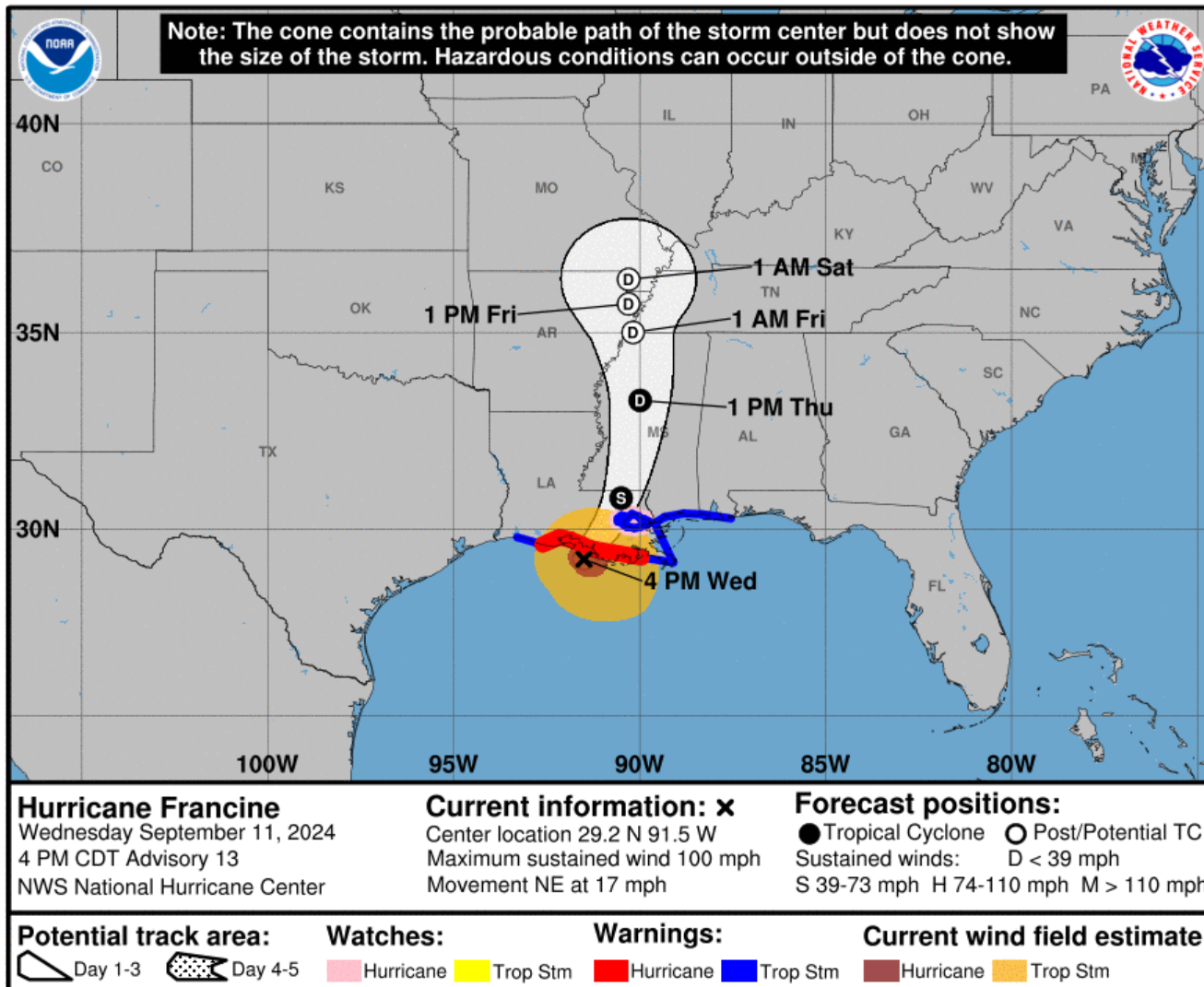
AFTERNOON ACTIONS

EOC was ready to lock down.

First responders stayed active until sustained winds were closer to 35-40mph.

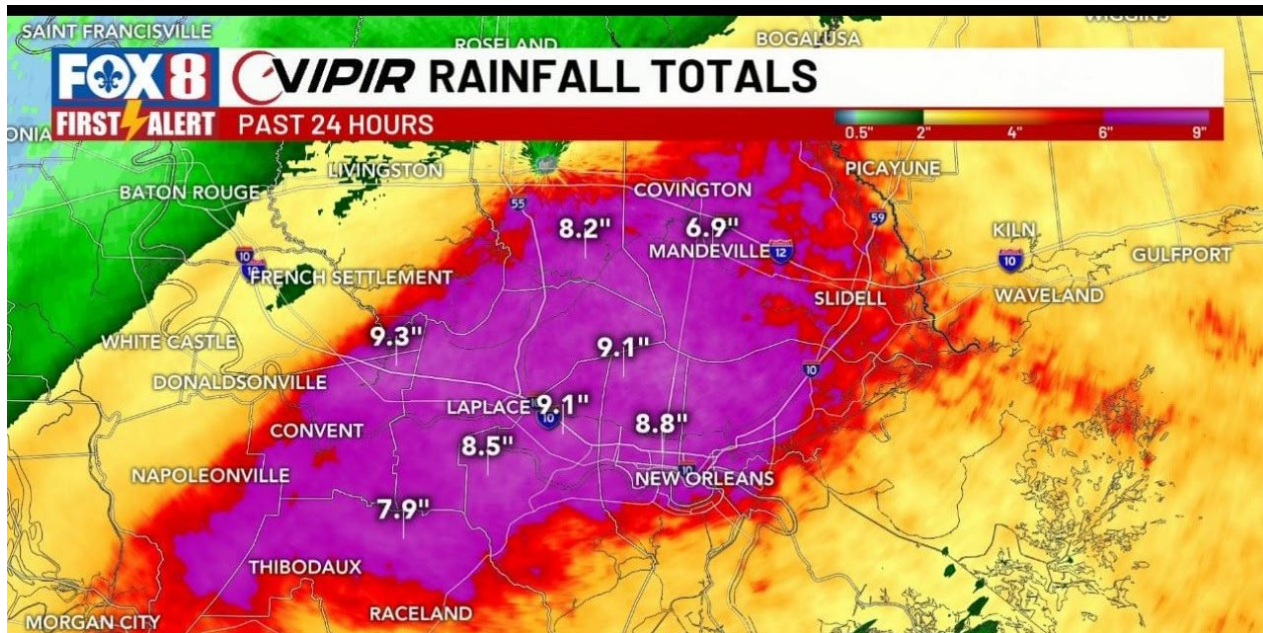
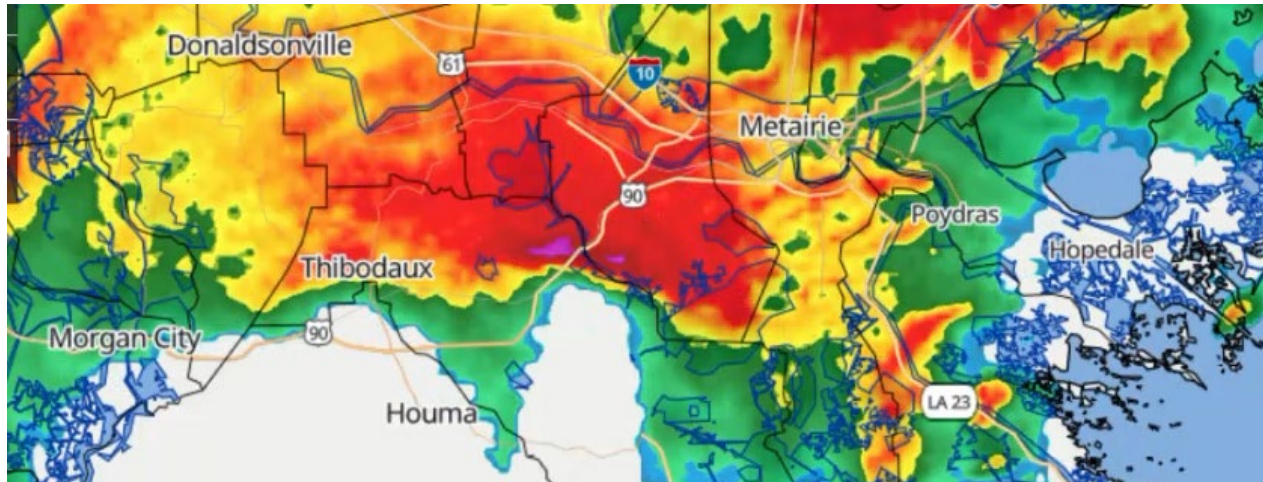
Francine actively:

- Landed at Category 1
- Moved fast (17 mph)
- Drop lighter rain (1"-3" over the day thus far)

Francine slowed to 3mph.

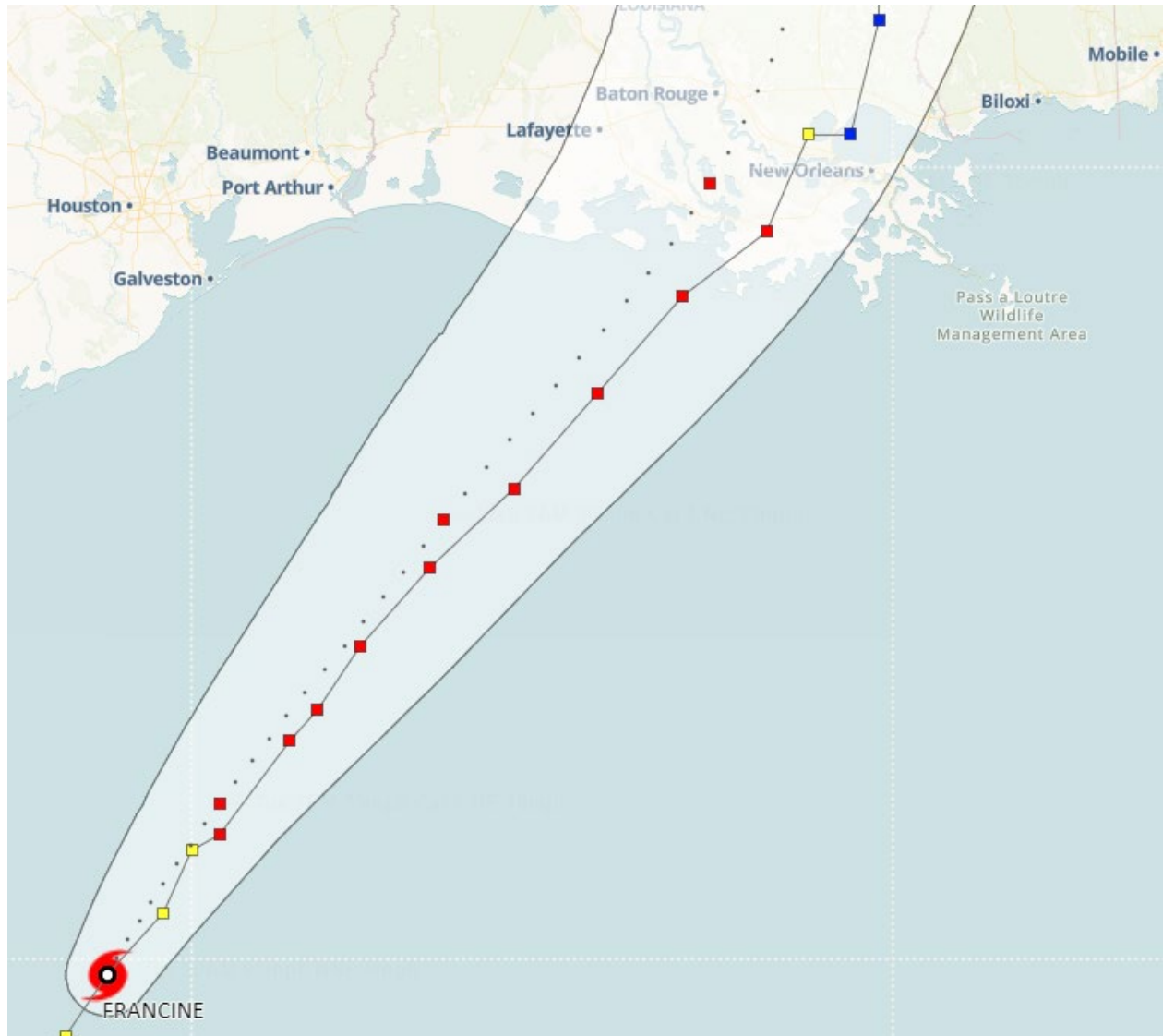
Dropped more than 9" of rain throughout the parish.

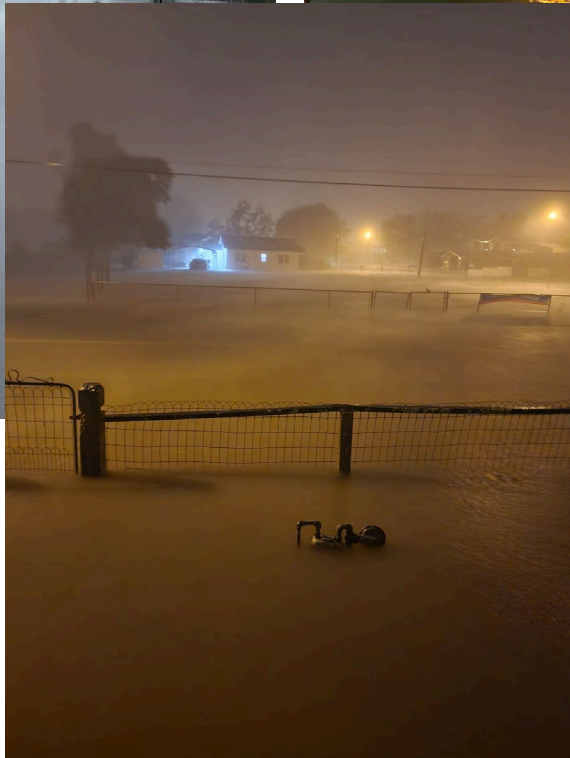

Parish Damage Assessment begins.

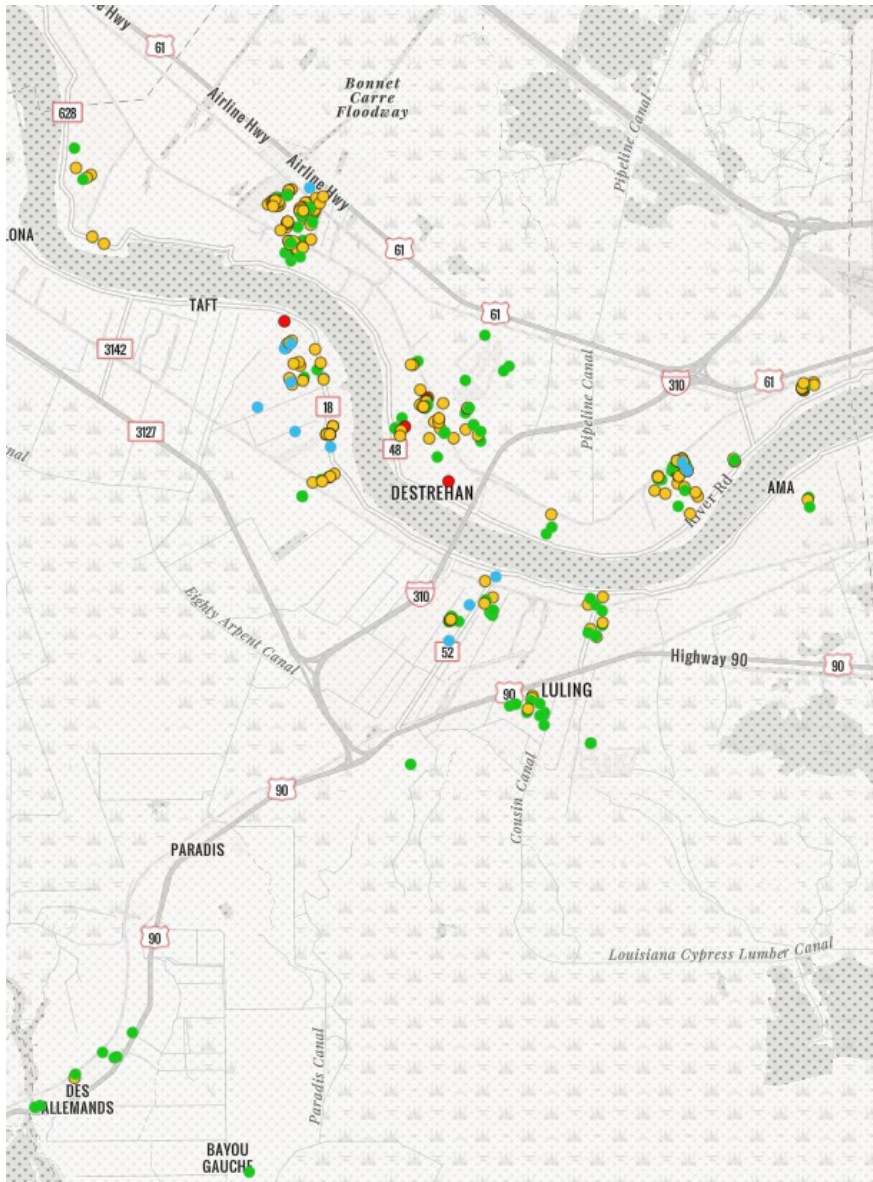
More individuals report flooding and damage.
