


Francine's Toll on St. Charles Parish



Prepare for activation and response to Potential Tropical Cyclone Six.




Monday, September 9, 2024

Sandbags were stationed at the East and West Bank Bridge Parks.




Tuesday, September 10, 2024

MORNING ACTIONS


Fully Activated EOC.


AFTERNOON ACTIONS


EOC was ready to lock down.

First responders stayed active until sustained winds were closer to 35-40mph.

Francine actively:

- Landed at Category 1
- Moved fast (17 mph)
- Drop lighter rain (1"-3" over the day thus far)

EVENING ACTIONS


Francine slowed to 3mph.

Dropped more than 9" of rain throughout the parish.


Image shows time period from 7pm to 9pm.


