A resolution in opposition to the Regionalization of the  
New Orleans International Airport.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Governmental Research has completed a report entitled  
New Orleans International Airport: Governance, Regional Cooperation  
and Airport Expansion; and,

WHEREAS, said report recommends that a broad-based regional authority be formed  
to sponsor and operate the Airport; and,

WHEREAS, the St. Charles Parish Council is currently working with the City of New  
Orleans and the New Orleans Aviation Board to address concerns  
regarding the Airport; and,

WHEREAS, it is deemed by the Parish Council to not be in the best interest of  
St. Charles Parish to support said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE  
ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL, do hereby express our opposition to the creation of  
a Regional Airport Authority to sponsor and operate the New Orleans International  
Airport.
