

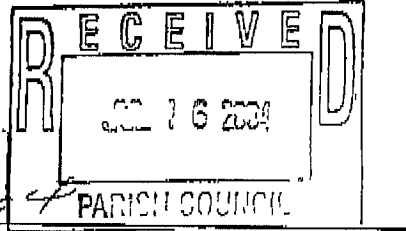

- Repetitious comments and subject matter will be strictly limited.

2. Why didn't the Parish use the entire 17 foot and 20 foot servitude as was available to them from the start of the job?
3. Can the Parish equipment (which they have two big sucker trucks that I know of) be able to get into the area to clean the catch basins that are being put down or do they figure well they will build-up and forget about it?
4. Where will the residents be required to reinstall their fences, when they do have to reinstall them, do they put it where they had it before in the middle of the servitude and then when something else comes along they will have to tear all those fences down again and will they be required to put gates on each side of their property if they do put it back there, I would like to know exactly where they will put it?
