Commissioner Booth: Next item on the agenda is PZO-2016-11 requested by Larry Cochran, Parish President for an ordinance to amend the St. Charles Parish Comprehensive Land Use Plan, entitled "St. Charles 2030" to update the Future Land Use Map.

Mr. Matherne: Thank you Mr. Chairman. As I'm sure you know in 2011 the St. Charles Parish Planning Commission and Council adopted the Comprehensive Land Use Plan. One of the pieces in that was the Future Land Use Map, you hear about it every time there is a proposal for a rezoning saying this is what the area is recommended to be in the future. As part of the 5 year plan we have taken a look at all of the times that because of a rezoning request the Commission and Council has actually modified that plan, it's been done 17 times in the last 5 years. We're in the process of updating all of the pieces of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan so it's time now to replace the map with one where all of the pieces have been changed, that's all we're asking to do. It's simply swapping out the old map for the new map with all the changes that have already been approved. We're not changing anything other than changing the actual map itself. Just housekeeping

Mr. Albert: We're asking for your confirmation that these are things that you have in fact done.

Commissioner Booth: Questions or comments on this one? I would like to commend all of your hard work to go electronic and the Council went along with our recommendation and we are now in the electronic age with our mapping which is a big step forward. Call for the vote. Oh public hearing, is anyone here to speak on behalf of this particular ordinance, St. Charles 2030? Seeing none, public hearing is closed now we can call for the vote
