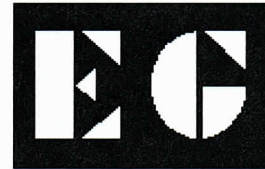

THE FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF ITEMS TO BE ADDRESSED. THESE ITEMS WERE NOTED PREVIOUSLY BETWEEN INSPECTOR, ENGINEER, AND CONTRACTOR; AND CONTRACTOR AGREES WITH THESE ITEMS.

- 1) Tighten 2 of the 4 bolts that secure the new pump to the deck. Value: \$500.00.
- 2) Secure the PVC float tube at the bottom of the sump. Value: \$800.00.
- 3) One plug is needed on the side of the existing soft start. Value: \$600.00.
- 4) Existing Generator needs to be loaded on a flatbed and removed from the site to the drop-off location coordinated with the Parish. This includes removing fuel from the generator prior to loading and hauling. Value: \$10,000.00.
- 5) Remove all sandbags from within the canal on both sides of the Station, and haul off-site for disposal. Value: \$2,000.00.
- 6) General cleanup of site, including hauling all trash and debris off-site; and restore all disturbed areas to original pre-construction condition, including laydown yard. Value: \$1,200.00.
- 7) Prepare and submit redline drawings. Value: \$600.00.
