- C. All utilities to be installed at the expense of the property owner or owners in accordance with parish specific cations and inspected by the Parish engineer.
- D. Street surface to be shelled by the Parish and point for by the applicant and applicant to pay five dollars [45.00] per front foot of lot toward a parish street maintenance program prior to issuance of a building permit.
- F. The right-of-way for roadway and utilities shall tot exceed seven hundred fifty (750) feet per block. A sixty (60) foot cross street shall be provided on the end of each block.


