Our mission is "to improve the health of the people we serve," and our commitment to St. Charles Parish is unwavering. We continue to expand in the number of patients we serve, and the variety of services we provide in pursuit of our mission.

Who Are We?

- First and foremost, we are members of the community. Serving as the Public Health Unit enables us to do more for St. Charles Parish than perhaps any other Federally Qualified Health Center in the state.
- > We provide almost 100 full-time jobs between our five clinics and school-based health centers in the parish.
- More than 20 of our employees here are healthcare providers, including: primary care physicians, specialty care physicians, nurse practitioners, dentists, psychiatrists, social workers, pharmacists, and more.

Who Do We Serve?

- Over 10,000 St. Charles Parish residents use the St. Charles Community Health Center for their primary care.
- > On average, we complete over 35,000 encounters for our patients on an annual basis.
- We serve more than 1,100 patients who are diabetic, and over 2,700 who are hypertensive striving to help keep their chronic diseases in check and keep them healthy and productive.
- > Our school-based health centers have provided pediatric care and behavioral health in over 3,500 visits.
