INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN

ST. CHARLES PARISH AND

DES ALLEMANDS VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into on this by and between:

St. Charles Parish, 15045 River Road, P.O. Box 302, Hahnville, LA 70057, herein represented by Albert D. Laque, its Parish President, duly authorized by Ordinance No. 07-4-8 adopted on the 16th day of April, 2007.

AND

The Des Allemands Volunteer Fire Department of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana, P.O. Box 817, Des Allemands, LA 70030, herein represented by Mule 1000 15, its 1005 devit duly authorized by Resolution of the Des Allemands Volunteer Fire Department adopted on the 20 day of 400 1 , 2007

the Constitution of the State of Louisiana and the Local Services Law of the WHEREAS, State of Louisiana provided for political subdivisions to engage in cooperative endeavors for public purposes with any public or private association, corporation or individual; and,

both the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Parish") and the WHEREAS, Des Allemands Volunteer Fire Department of the Parish of St. Charles, State of Louisiana (the "Department") are authorized by law to provide fire protection service; and,

there exists a need to construct a building at 16960 Highway 90 for the WHEREAS, Department; and,

the Department is not in a financial position to construct said building without WHEREAS, funds being made available to cover the expense until sales tax bonds are issued from the one-eight of one-percent (1/8%) sales tax authorized by an election held in the Parish on December 8, 1979 (the "Bonds"); and,

it is the desire of the Parish President and the Parish Council to provide said WHEREAS. funds to be repaid to the Parish from the issuance of the Bonds in accordance with the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED THAT:

St. Charles Parish shall:

Appropriate and allocate up to \$920,000 for the construction of a building at 16960 Highway 90 for the Department, being the cost of said building and related expenses determined by public bid. 2)

Provide said funding as invoices are received and approved by the Des Allemands Volunteer Fire Department.

When the Bonds are issued, to deduct the debt service of the \$920,000 being used to 3) repay the Parish for the advance from the amount normally distributed to the Department.

Des Allemands Volunteer Fire District shall:

- Assume all liability for the construction of a building at 16960 Highway 90 and hereby agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Parish from and against any and all claims, suits, damages, costs (including attorney's fees) losses and expense which it may suffer or pay out by reason of, resulting from or arising out of the purchase of said building, and does hereby agree to maintain and provide General Liability along with Property and Fire Insurance with replacement cost value.
- Execute any required documents necessary to facilitate the object of this Agreement.
