- 3. The proposed budget was submitted to the governing authority and made available for public inspection at least 15 days prior to the beginning of the budget year (LSA-RS 39:1305).
- To the extent that proposed expenditures were greater than \$250,000, we have made the budget available for public inspection and have advertised its availability in our official journal. The advertisement included the date, time, and place of the public hearing on the budget. Notice has also been published certifying that all actions required by the Local Government Budget Act have been completed (LSA-RS 39.1306).
- 5. The proposed budget was made available for public inspection at the location required by LSA-RS 39:1307.
- All action necessary to adopt and finalize the budget was completed prior to year end The adopted budget contained the same information as that required for the proposed budget [LSA-RS 39 1304(c)].
- After adoption, a certified copy of the budget has been retained by the chief executive officer or equivalent officer (LSA-RS 39:1308).
