The Agreement Between the State of Louisiana, Louisiana Housing Finance Agency ("Agency") and St. Charles Parish Department of Community Services(Contractor), which Agreement became effective July 1, 2001 and is in effect until September 30, 2001, is hereby amended as follows:

**Change agreement from:** Item # 9: September 30, 2001  
Item # 11: Maximum Contract Amount: \$26,627

**Change agreement to:** Item # 9: December 31, 2001  
Item # 11: Maximum Contract Amount: \$103,172

**Exhibit A is revised to include an increase of the Federal Fiscal year 2001 allocation**

This amendment shall be valid and shall take effect upon execution of same by the President of the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency and the authorized representative of the Contractor. A fully executed copy of this amendment shall be attached to the original Agreement and become a part of the Agreement thereof.

If Contractor fails to have this amendment executed within five (5) days of receipt of said amendment from the Agency, the Agency shall have cause to terminate the Agreement.
