RESOLUTION NO. 5274

A resolution providing mandatory support for a Special Permit for The German Coast Farmers' Market, a green market, to operate on the site of The St. Charles Plaza, 12715 Hwy 90, Luling.

WHEREAS, The St. Charles Parish Zoning Ordinance requires both Planning Commission approval and a supporting resolution of the Parish Council for a Special Permit to operate a green market in a C-2 zoning district; and,

WHEREAS, The German Coast Farmers' Market, which has operated successfully on the east bank of St. Charles Parish for two years and wishes to expand operations to offer a similar green market on the west bank at the site of St. Charles Plaza, a C-2 zoning district; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission has approved the request;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL, does hereby provide a supporting resolution for The German Coast Farmers' Market to operate a green market on the site of St. Charles Plaza, 12715 Highway 90, in Luling as outlined in PZSPU 2005-05.
