**ORDINANCE NO.** <u>11-12-1</u>

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10-4-17, an Agreement between Sizeler Thompson Brown Architects – Regional Design Group, LLC, and St. Charles Parish, to provide for additional architectural services and changes in project representation and geotechnical and testing services for the Edward A. Dufresne Community Center, located at 274 Judge Edward Dufresne Parkway (formerly Sugarland Parkway) in Luling.

- WHEREAS, on April 19, 2010, the St. Charles Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. 10-4-17 approving an Agreement with Sizeler Thompson Brown Architects Regional Design Group, LLC, and St. Charles Parish to provide for architectural services for the Edward A. Dufresne Community Center; and,
- WHEREAS, on December 6, 2010, the St. Charles Parish Council adopted Ordinance No. 10-12-2 amending Ordinance No. 10-4-17 to provide for additional architectural services for the three alternates: the Equipment Storage Facility, the additional bay on the gymnasium, and the generator; and,
- WHEREAS, during the design of the community center, significant changes in the general scope, extent or character of the project in said Agreement were requested, which required additional architectural services, as well as changes in project representation and geotechnical and testing services; and,
- WHEREAS, Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to said Agreement has been prepared to provide for the additional architectural services and changes in project representation and geotechnical and testing services; and,
- **WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Parish Council to approve Supplemental Agreement No. 2.

#### THE ST. CHARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS:

**SECTION I.** That Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Agreement between Sizeler Thompson Brown Architects – Regional Design Group, LLC, and St. Charles Parish to provide for additional architectural services and changes in project representation and geotechnical and testing services for the Edward A. Dufresne Community Center is hereby approved.

**SECTION II.** That the Parish President is hereby authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 2 on behalf of the Parish of St. Charles.

# SUPPLEMENT NO. 2 AGREEMENT BETWEEN OWNER AND ARCHITECT/ENGINEER FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, an Agreement for Professional Services St. Charles Parish, 15045 River Road, Post Office Box 302, Hahnville, Louisiana, 70057 (OWNER) and Sizeler Thompson Brown Architects – Regional Design Group, LLC, 300 Lafayette Street, Suite 200, New Orleans, Louisiana, 70130 (ARCHITECT/ENGINEER) was entered into on April 20, 2010, for Architectural/Engineering services for the construction of the community center, located at 274 Judge Edward Dufresne Parkway (formerly Sugarland Parkway) in Luling; and,

WHEREAS, the original Agreement between OWNER and ARCHITECT/ENGINEER for Professional Services includes the following fees:

<u>Design Services:</u> Lump sum fee of <u>Three Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand</u>, <u>Eight Hundred Twenty Five Dollars even (\$339,825.00)</u>;

<u>Project Representation Services:</u> Lump sum fee of <u>Forty Nine Thousand</u>, <u>Six Hundred Sixty Dollars even (\$49,660.00)</u>, which lump sum fee was calculated on estimated man hours indicated in Exhibit "D" of said Agreement; and,

<u>Professional Associated and Consultants:</u> A cost reimbursable basis not to exceed <u>Fifty Two Thousand Dollars even</u>, (\$52,000.00) for all related Geotechnical and Testing Services, which lump sum fee was calculated on estimated man hours indicated in EXHIBIT "F" of said Agreement.

WHEREAS, Supplement No. 1 to said Agreement was entered into by the OWNER and ARCHITECT/ENGINEER on December 7, 2010, for Architectural/Engineering services for three Alternates: the Equipment Storage Facility, the additional bay on the gymnasium, and the generator, and the OWNER agreed that the three Alternates are in addition to the General Scope of the Project in the original Agreement, which is to provide Architectural/Engineering services for the construction of the community center, and to pay the ARCHITECT/ENGINEER as follows:

<u>Design Services:</u> Lump sum fee of <u>Four Hundred Forty Five Thousand</u>, <u>Eight Hundred Twenty Five Dollars even (\$445,825.00)</u>.

And, WHEREAS, during the design of the community center, the OWNER agrees that significant changes in the general scope, extent or character of the Project in the original Agreement were requested, which required additional Design Services of the ARCHITECT/ENGINEER, as well as changes in Project Representation and Geotechnical and Testing Services,

NOW THEREFORE, the OWNER and ARCHITECT/ENGINEER do hereby mutually agree that the OWNER shall pay ARCHITECT/ENGINEER as follows:

<u>Design Services:</u> Lump sum fee of <u>Eight Hundred Fourteen Thousand</u>, <u>Eleven Dollars even (\$814,011.00)</u>;

<u>Project Representation Services:</u> A cost reimbursable basis not to exceed <u>Sixty Eight Thousand</u>, <u>Fifty Five Dollars even (\$68,055.00)</u>, which lump sum fee was calculated on estimated man hours indicated in the attached Exhibit "D"; and,

<u>Professional Associated and Consultants:</u> A cost reimbursable basis not to exceed <u>Seventy Three Thousand even, (\$73,000.00)</u> for all related Geotechnical and Testing Services, which lump sum fee was calculated on estimated man hours indicated in the attached EXHIBIT "F" and EXHIBIT "G".
