SECT	ARLES PARISH COUNCIL HEREBY ORDAINS: ION I. That the St. Charles Parish Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15 Motor
	Traffic by adding Sec 15-25 Shrubs and trees within Parish right of ways or
servitudes.	
	Shrubs and trees.
(a)	No private shrubs or trees and the like shall be positioned within any Parish right of way or servitude nor shall any such existing plantings be allow to remain unless authorized by Ordinance. This restriction is to (1) prevent shrubs or trees and the like from blocking vehicular travel sight lines, and (2) not hinder or unreasonably interfere with the purpose for which the servitude or right of way is granted or used. When such plantings are found to violate this Ordinance, the property owner adjacent to such existing plantings shall be notified by certified mail or by personal delivery by the Planning & Zoning Department the these plantings are to be removed by the Parish after the elapse of 28 days following the notice unless documented exist that an ordinance is being prepared to allow for these such items to remain.  Any shrubs or trees and the like contained within a median crossing or median entrance to any subdivision shall be excluded from these provisions, provided items do not block vehicular travel sight lines.
