

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith, a lifelong resident of St. Charles Parish, husband of the late Donyce Jackson Smith, father of Glen Smith and Gary Smith, Sr. and the late Kirk Smith, grandfather of State Representative Gary L. Smith, Jr., Rebecca Tassin and Madison Smith, great-grandfather of Ashlyn Tassin, Megan Tassin, and Henry Smith, and devoted companion to Cathy Montz; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith worked until his death in his well-known construction company of 25 years Fremin-Smith Services and was the nucleus and guiding force of the development of the Magnolia Companies, a multi-company conglomerate; and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Smith represented St. Charles Parish in many different capacities: the New Orleans Aviation Board for over 26 years, Elected Member to the Democratic State Central Committee for over 20 years, as well as Treasurer of the State Democratic Party, and a business leader and philanthropist; and,

He was very well respected and considered by all who knew him to be fair, honest, and upstanding. He was an inspiration and mentor to many in the political and business worlds; and,










WHEREAS, the DOTD and the Sponsor previously entered into a formal agreement, dated May 29, 2009 and Supplemental Agreement No. 1, dated September 7, 2011, for constructing a multi-use path on the eastbank of the Mississippi River levee; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Agreement to increase the Federal Funding; and

WHEREAS, the DOTD is agreeable to the changes in the implementation of the Project and desires to cooperate with the Sponsor as hereinafter provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual dependent covenants herein contained, the parties hereto agree to amend the May 29, 2009 Agreement and Supplemental Agreement No. 1 of September 7, 2011, as follows:

1.

Article II – Funding is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Except for services hereinafter specifically listed to be furnished at the DOTD's expense or at the Sponsor's expense, as the case may be, the cost of this project will be a joint participation between the Sponsor and the Federal Highway Administration, hereinafter "FHWA", with the Sponsor contributing the 5% match of the participating construction cost and the FHWA contributing, through the DOTD, the remaining 95%. The maximum federal funds available for this project are \$865,000. With this funding option, the Sponsor agrees to provide all design and construction inspection at its own expense. The Sponsor may incorporate items of work into the construction contract not eligible for Federal-Aid participation at its own costs. Funds will be disbursed as provided in Article XII {Cost Disbursements}.

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"No Notice to Proceed shall be issued and no compensable costs for construction may be incurred prior to a formal notification from DOTD that FHWA authorization has been received. Any costs for which the Sponsor expects to be reimbursed for incurred prior to such authorization will not be compensable."

The DOTD and the Parish of St. Charles agree that all provisions of the Original Agreement between the parties dated May 29, 2009, and Supplemental Agreement No. 1 dated September 7, 2011, to the extent not inconsistent with Supplemental Agreement No. 2 of the Sponsor/State Agreement, shall remain in full force and effect.
