WHEREAS, more than 6 million Americans are living with Alzheimer's and by the year 2050, this number is projected to rise to nearly 13 million; and,

WHEREAS, researchers around the world continue their efforts to develop scientific discoveries that could one day bring about a world without Alzheimer's disease; and,


