An ordinance to provide for the installation of "ALL-WAY STOP" signs at the intersection of Lorraine Street and Amie Street, in Gabriel Heights Subdivision, in Destrehan.

- **WHEREAS,** the St. Charles Parish Code of Ordinances, Chapter 15 Motor Vehicles and Traffic provides for the installation of traffic control signs; and,
