Interested parties are hereby notified that the Coastal Management Division of the Department of Natural Resources has received the following application for a Coastal Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with the State and Local Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S.49, Sections 214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulation of the Coastal Resources Program.

Application has also been made to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and provisions of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.L. 95-217).

DESCRIPTION:

Installation of two 8" pipelines (±10,476' in length) with a 30' permanent right-of-way and 20' temporary right-of-way to transport P/P mix and butanes from the Orion Refinery to the Enterprise Norco Refactionator. The pipelines will be buried a minimum of 3' below the surface. Directional drill sites with temporary workspaces will be used to cross the Kansas City Southern Railroad, an old pit, US Hwy, 61 and Airline Canal, a congested pipeline corridor, and the canal in front of the Shell/Motiva Plant. Approx. 7,240 cu. yds. of native soils will be excavated with a backhoe, placed in a ±10' wide area adjacent to the pipe ditch, and as backfill when the pipeline installation is complete. Approx. 14.5 acres of developed uplands and approx. 3.26 acres of forested wetlands will be impacted as a result of this activity.*

The official date of the beginning of the public comment period for Coastal Use Permits and Water Quality Certification applications begins on the date of publication of the notice in the official state journal (The Advocate), in accordance with the Rules and Procedures for Coastat Use Permits, §723.C.5.c. The Coastal Management Division will inform interested parties of the exact date of publication on request.

Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from anyone having an interest in this permit request. Comments to the State of Louisiana, Coastal Management Division must be mailed within 25 days of the date of official journal publication of this notice to Coastal Management Division, Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, P.O. box 44487, Capitol Station, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70804-4487. State of Louisiana Coastal Use Permit Criteria

The decision on whether or not to issue a Coastal Use Permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impacts of the proposed activity in accordance with the state policies outlined in R.S. 49:214.22. The decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The decision must be consistent with the state program and approved local programs for affected parishes and must represent an appropriate balancing of social, environmental and economic factors. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered; among these are flood and storm hazards, water quality, water supply, feasible alternative sites, drainage patterns, historical sites, economics, public and private benefits, coastal water dependency, impacts on natural features, compatibility with the natural and cultural setting and the extent of long term benefits or adverse impacts.

State of Louisiana Water Quality Certification Criteria

In accordance with the Joint Public Notice Agreement between Coastal Management Division and the Office of Water Resources, notice is hereby given that the applicant has applied to the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, Office of Environmental Services for a Water Quality Certification in accordance with statutory authority contained in the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Chapter 11, Part IV, Section 2074 A(3) and provision of Section 401 of the Clean Water Act (P.L. 95-217).



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


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


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
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
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
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WET LAND DETAIL



- 1. APPROXIMATELY 7,420± CUBIC YARDS OF SPOIL MATERIAL WILL BE EXCAVATED BY BACK HOE. SPOIL WILL BE PLACED ADJACENT TO PIPE DITCH DURING CONSTRUCTION. FOLLOWING CONSTRUCTION, SPOIL WILL BE RETURNED TO DITCH.
