# Contract Monitoring Mosquito Control

#### St. Charles Mosquito Control

(Contract Thru Dec. 2016)

#### **Control Measures:**

 Larval control is the first defense in any mosquito program.

 To date Mosquito Control Inc. has sprayed in excess of 30 million sq. ft. of floodwater and permanent breeding sites





#### **CONTRACT MONITOR**

#### St. Charles Mosquito Control

 Ground Adulticiding has resulted in 8,200 miles sprayed by truck. Covering over 240,000 acres.



#### **CONTRACT MONITOR**

#### St. Charles Mosquito Control

- Encephalitis activity in the State and in the Parish has been much lower than in the previous years and has been running about a ½ of the activity seen during the peak years of 2004 and 2012.
- 7 incidents of encephalitis activity have been found in St. Charles this year.

- Looking for high populations of vector mosquitoes
- Parish wide use of multiple surveillance traps and methods
- Larva sampling
- · Additional inspections
- · Focused treatments
- Public education

#### Threshold Treatments

- Thorough inspections
- Frequent adulticiding treatments
- Re-trapping
- · Public information distribution
