In 2024 we had 15,989 log entries





2025 Seasonal Outlook

Forecasters predict an above average season. They predict a 33% chance of a hurricane making landfall between Florida Panhandle and Brownsville, Texas.

Predictions (70% probability for the following) activities

17 Named Storms
9 Hurricanes

5 Major Hurricanes

Forecast Basics:

- Outlook reflects current El Nino neutral
- Sea surface temperatures are above normal.
- Anticipate an above average probability for major hurricanes making landfall along the continental US and Caribbean.
