

Dear Assessor,

On behalf of Union Carbide Corporation (Dow), we submit this formal appeal of the 2025 assessment for the St. Charles site, with supporting schedules and documentation for both inventory and machinery & equipment.

Inventory - Catalyst Reporting and Valuation Alignment: To ensure the 2025 assessment accurately reflects inventory within St. Charles Parish as of January 1, we have reconciled system status to physical counts as of the lien date. The attached disclosure and schedules provide this tie-out. For Dow's leased precious metals embedded in catalyst assemblies, we report the lessee's possessory interest at fair market value, net of refining, removal, and return obligations, with supporting documentation available.

Machinery & Equipment - Flare Gas Recovery (FGR) and Pollution Control Valuation (Mandated by Federal Consent Decree): The Flare Gas Recovery (FGR) systems newly reported at St. Charles Operations were installed and are operated pursuant to a federal Consent Decree - *United States, et al. v. The Dow Chemical Company, et al.*, Civil Action No. 2:21-cv-114, U.S. District Court, Eastern District of Louisiana (entered June 9, 2021, signed by Judge Martin Feldman).

This Consent Decree is a matter of public record, was subject to public notice and comment, and is available through the federal court docket and the Department of Justice. It documents the legal requirement for Dow and Union Carbide to install and operate pollution control (FGRs) equipment at the St. Charles facility under the Clean Air Act and Louisiana law. These FGR systems are pollution-control facilities with no independent income-producing or production-use function. Pursuant to La. R.S. 47:1977 (Act 69), we request these be valued at fair market value defined as the "actual net value realizable in a fair and voluntary sale." Given the specialized, site-integrated nature of these assets and their limited secondary market, our preliminary analysis supports a value of approximately 10% of installed cost, which we can substantiate via a component-level market analysis or functional obsolescence appraisal.



We are in the process of submitting Form R-1349 to LDR for LDEQ certification only (no state sales/use tax refund is sought), to support special assessment under Act 69 / La. R.S. 47:1977. Dow is prepared to seek Board of Commerce & Industry acknowledgment following LDEQ certification, or sooner at your preference, to formalize Act 69 treatment for subsequent rolls. If timing requires, we respectfully request an interim functional obsolescence adjustment for the 2025 roll, with finalization upon receipt of certification.

If any peripheral components are not strictly pollution-control (e.g., common utility supports), Dow is prepared to identify and exclude them; our request focuses on the pollution-control machinery and process skids.
